Shipping to Spain

Shipments over €150

Due to local government requirements, further information is needed for shipments destined to Spain which are valued at over €150.

What is required?

When we submit your > €150 shipment for Customs clearance into Spain we also need to provide the receiver's DNI. This applies to both DAP and DT1 shipments.

What is a DNI?

The DNI (Documento Nacional de Identidad) is the Spanish national identity card, which has a 9-digit long identification number.



The Spanish authorities require this number in order for them to monitor the volume of high value shipments per citizen.

How can I provide a DNI?

We advise that this number is provided in the 'Receiver's VAT/ EORI No.' field when making your booking.

What if I can't provide the DNI?

NIE number (DNI's equivalent for foreign residents) can also be provided. If a DNI or NIE are not given and the parcel has been sent EDAP, the shipment will be automatically returned.

Recipients of DAP parcels have the opportunity to provide this number when the normal duty payment request is made.

Please note DNI or NIE will not be be stored in our database therefore it needs to be sent for each shipment.

Sending to a business?

For B2B traffic, the DNI is not needed. Instead, please provide the EORI number for the Importing business. We advise that this is provided at the point of shipping. The importer may be contacted to request their VAT number before the clearance.

As with DNI requests, these shipments will be held for 1 week awaiting this information.
